The faithful wonder whether their words, which are sometimes uttered out of desperation, will make a difference. Is there an attitude or position that can assure them that their words are heard? Jesus taught that effective words of prayer are infused with power when uttered with humility of spirit rather than out of self-righteousness.

Goal for the Learners

- ✓ To hear what the Pharisee said that was so wrong and what the tax collector said that was right.
- ✓ To appreciate the difference between selfrighteous platitudes and true gratitude for God's mercy and grace.
- To inspect, and if necessary to correct, the motivation for their own piety.

Lesson Challenges for the Week

- Be aware of people who act with humility.
 Sometimes those who do brave deeds where others hail as heroes do not see themselves in that light. What separates these people from so many others who do all they can to be recognized and praised?
- Research the Pharisees. Although they are often portrayed negatively in the Scriptures, they have many admirable qualities that made them worthy opponents of Jesus.
- Pray daily for God's grace and mercy to abound in your life.
