People are constantly tossed about by the trials and tribulations of life. Where can they find safe haven? Paul tells the Romans that through the love of God in Christ Jesus they will find a Savior from whose love they can never be separated and by whom they will be loved, protected, glorified, and delivered from all trials and tribulations.

Goal for the Learners

- ✓ To study the principal points of Paul's teaching on Jesus from whose love believers can never be separated by any turmoil or hardship.
- ✓ To believe that Christ Jesus was God's plan for humankind from the beginning of creation.
- ✓ To share the joy and love of Christ with others.

Lesson Challenges for the Week

- Pray for those who are being buffeted about by literal or figurative storms of life. Offer whatever tangible assistance you can.
- Memorize today's key verse from Romans 8:31b: "If God is for us, who is against us?" Call this verse to mind whenever you feel that some person, experience, or unseen power is trying to separate you from God. Affirm that you are safe and secure in God's loving care.
- Recall how God has cared for you in the midst of life's challenges. Give thanks for what God has already done and rest assured that God will continue to care for you.
