- ✓ To review God's judgment of Judah and Israel.
- ✓ To encourage sensitivity toward social injustice.
- ✓ To address issues of injustice in local and global communities.

Lesson Challenges for the Week

- Be on the lookout for people who are being treated unjustly in your community. Are there laws that need to be changed? Are their attitudes among the residents that need to be changed? What can you do to create a more just environment for those who ha e been treated unjustly?
- Talk directly to someone who is acting unjustly. Tell this person about God's expectations for justice. Help to change this person's actions and attitudes.
- Research the actions of Saint Nikolai Evangelical Lutheran Church in Leipzig, Germany that led to the fall of the Berlin Wall. How could similar peaceful actions in your own community cause barriers to just treatment for all to fall? (e.g. addressing the criminal justice systems)
