Goal for the Learners

- ✓ To explore God's response to injustice as recorded by Amos.
- ✓ To reflect upon ways individuals practice greed and selfishness.
- ✓ To discover ways God does justice in the midst of injustice and how humans can join God in the fight against injustice.

Lesson Challenges for the Week

- Investigate socially responsible investing.
 How can you support companies that
 share your ethical values, particularly
 concerning justice for all people?
- Review your income and assets. How much truly is enough for you to live on? How are you acquiring whatever resources you have? What do you think Jesus would say to you about your lifestyle and your treatment of others, particularly in light of your lifestyle?
- Look around your community or region. Do you observe any unjust practices, such as toxic products being disposed of in a poor community, or poor communities, lacking affordably priced groceries, or a lack of medical services? With whom can you work to change whatever unjust practices you observe?
